- **Cultivate calling within your congregation**

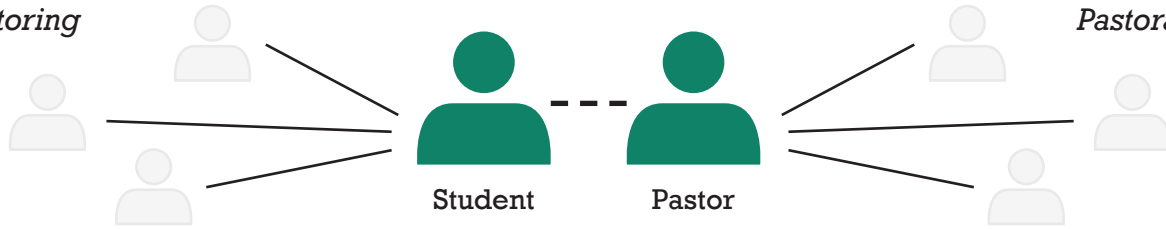


Mentoring Leaders
