In order to meet degree requirements for the M.A.C.M., the student must complete a minimum of 38 hours (32 core hours of study in Theology and 6 hours electives from CoPA). In order to meet degree requirements for the M.S., the student must complete a minimum number of 30 hours.

Graduation Requirements:

Minimum 3.0 GPA in CoPA classes and 2.5 GPA in Theology classes and completion of all course requirements and 62 hours within maximum timeframe of six years.
